

Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment

Ennoconn Corporation is committed to promoting energy conservation, carbon reduction and waste reduction measures to mitigate the impact of climate change, and fully recognizes the importance of biodiversity and ecological conservation. In line with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)*, Ennoconn Corporation commits to starting from its own operations and working together with its subsidiaries, supply chain (or value chain), and strategic partners to promote biodiversity, environmental protection, and no deforestation. Ennoconn Corporation aims to further promote ecological and forest conservation, fulfill its corporate social responsibility, enhance environmental and social well-being, and remain accountable to stakeholders.

COMMITMENT

1. Ennoconn Corporation's own operations, subsidiaries, suppliers (value chain) and strategic partners shall avoid conducting operations or setting up plants in or near sites containing globally or nationally important biodiversity areas in compliance with international and local laws and regulations.
2. If Ennoconn Corporation's own operations, subsidiaries, and suppliers (value chain) involve changes in land use, including land allocation and utilization for factory construction or expansion, they shall comply with applicable national laws and regulations to conduct environmental impact assessments, monitor risks to biodiversity and forest ecosystems, identify priority management areas, and set management targets. Impact mitigation measures, including avoidance, mitigation, restoration, and offsetting, shall be implemented to achieve zero net loss (No Net Loss).
3. Ennoconn Corporation supports the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) and other biodiversity-related initiatives, and gradually conducts biodiversity risk assessments. Ennoconn Corporation aims to achieve Net Positive Impact on biodiversity and No Net Deforestation by 2050 across its global operating sites, and is committed to biodiversity conservation and avoiding deforestation activities.

4. Ennoconn Corporation promotes green office practices and green procurement, encourages paperless practices, and prioritizes the procurement of paper products with lower environmental impacts, including Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)-certified paper, other forest-friendly certified paper, recycled eco-friendly paper, and eco-friendly printing inks.
5. Ennoconn Corporation inventories the amount of wood used in own business activities, including photocopying paper, household paper, packaging paper, building materials, and office furniture, etc., and plans to invest resources in forest restoration activities, with the goal of achieving No Net Deforestation by 2050.
6. Ennoconn Corporation promotes and raises the awareness of internal and external stakeholders, such as employees, shareholders, customers, strategic partners, and suppliers (value chain), on environmental protection such as biodiversity and forest conservation.
7. This commitment is incorporated into Ennoconn Corporation's "Supplier Code of Conduct" and the "Supplier ESG Self-Assessment Questionnaire". Ennoconn Corporation seeks to work with suppliers (value chain), strategic partners, and external stakeholders to jointly advocate for and support biodiversity and no deforestation initiatives.
